
"Certification and traceability have the potential to drive the adoption of digital technology by unifying the needs of all stakeholder"

Title: "Digital Technology Adoption in Shrimp Aquaculture: Systematic Review".

Background: Various digital technologies have been widely adopted in shrimp aquaculture. However, the needs of different stakeholders are not being met due to the absence of standards.

Objective: Investigate the motivation for digital technology adoption in shrimp aquaculture and the possibility of improving its adoption.

Result: Keywords were extracted from 36 articles after being filtered through the PRISMA 2020 guideline; the frequency of their occurrence fluctuated over time. Significantly more publications are published during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Result: The motivation of digital technology adoption in shrimp aquaculture among the biggest Asian shrimp exporter countries are regulation, profitability, modernization, productivity, and sustainability. But fewer countries are motivated by certification and traceability.

Search string: ("digital" OR "smart" OR "iot" OR "internet of things" OR "ict" OR "information") AND "technology" AND ("acceptance" OR "adoption") AND "aquaculture"

Database: ScienceDirect & Web of Science

Filter the result by shrimp aquaculture in six biggest Asian shrimp exporter countries: China, India, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Thailand, and Vietnam

Limitation: We only include articles that were written in English language.
