



Visa Information for Participants – World Aquaculture Singapore 2026 (WA2026 Singapore)

Participants attending World Aquaculture Singapore 2026 are advised to review the following visa and entry requirements prior to travel.

1. Check if You Require an Entry Visa

Entry Visa Requirements

Singapore grants visa-free entry to nationals of many countries for short-term visits. However, participants from certain countries are required to obtain an Entry Visa prior to arrival.

In general, travelers from countries such as Afghanistan, Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Iran, Iraq, Syria, Nigeria, Sudan, Somalia, and selected others may require a visa.

All participants are strongly encouraged to check their visa requirements with the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) Singapore before making travel arrangements.

2. Letter of Introduction (LOI) / Form V39A

If you require a Letter of Introduction (ICA Form V39A), please contact Xperience DMC Private Limited at Email: contact@xperiencedmc.com **together** with your confirmed event WA2026 registration for assistance.

Xperience DMC Private Limited facilitates the issuance of ICA Form V39A for confirmed World Aquaculture Singapore 2026 participants only. An administration fee will apply, and a payment link will be provided upon request.

Alternatively, if you book your accommodation through any of the links provided in our preferred hotel on the event website, they will be waiving the LOI fee. Kindly share your booking confirmation with them for verification.

Please note each Singapore Entry Visa application is unique and all approval is subject to the discretion of Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) Singapore.

3. Important Notes

- LOI (V39A) issuance is strictly for WA2026 participants who have registered to the event only.
- The LOI (V39A) supports your visa application but does not guarantee approval.
- All visa applications are subject to the approval and discretion of the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) Singapore.
- Entry requirements and visa policies may change; participants should always verify the latest information prior to travel.

4. SG Arrival Card (SGAC)

All travelers are required to [submit the SG Arrival Card](#) **within three (3) days** (including the day of arrival) before arriving in Singapore, **except**:

- Those transiting/transferring through Singapore without seeking immigration clearance; and
- Singapore citizens, Permanent Residents and Long-Term Pass Holders entering via land checkpoints.

Submission of SGAC is Free and can be done via the [SGAC e-Service](#) or [MyICA Mobile app](#). Travelers who fail to submit SGAC may be denied entry into Singapore. For more information on SGAC submission, refer to [SGAC with Electronic Health Declaration](#).
