



## International Tropical Rock Oyster Workshop

The International Tropical Rock Oyster Workshop hosted by NT Fisheries and The Pacific Community (SPC), supported by the Cooperative Research Centre for Developing Northern Australia (CRCNA), will bring together a broad range of stakeholders to discuss the status and current knowledge of tropical oyster aquaculture research and development. This will provide an opportunity to share experiences and develop an international network for tropical oyster aquaculture development. We will discuss and document current bottlenecks/issues confronting development of tropical oyster farming, such as; hatchery production, animal health, grow-out technology and shellfish quality assurance.
