Post Conference **Farm Tour** at APA17 *Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, 28th, July 2017*

On 28th July, there will be a farm tour organised by **the Malaysian Fisheries Society**. The full day farm tour will include visits to marine fish cage farming activities, an indoor marine fish farm, nursery and hatchery and a shrimp farm in Selangor.

Schedule:

Morning visit:

- Depart from PWTC to Port Klang, transfer by boat to Ketam Island.
- Visit KS Aquaculture, an integrated marine aquaculture company, the largest cage farm in Malaysia with 4,000 cages off the island, farming king/ tiger grouper, red snapper, pompano and Asian sea bass.

Lunch:

- Seafood restaurant in Pulau Ketam Island (Crab Island)

Afternoon visit:

- Oasis Long Diann Bio-tech Sdn. Bhd., an indoor RAS facility to produce market size hybrid groupers. Oasis has hatchery and nursery for fry and fingerling production.
- This will be followed by a visit to a small and successful vannamei shrimp farm MyRezky, with 14 ponds producing 6-7 tonnes/ha/cycle. The farm is successful in culturing shrimp in low salinity and low alkalinity pond water. Both farms are located around Banting, Selangor.
